

Estimate?

Bid?

Estimate

A best guess at what a project will cost

Quote

An estimate that is expected to be a final price and which will remain in effect for a fixed length of time.

Bid

A competitive quote, to be compared with other bids, often in search of the lowest price.

Confirmation

Written, signed agreement to all of the terms of an estimate, bid, or quote.

Invoice

Final presentation of charges to a client for payment.

License

Written grant of the permitted rights to the buyer of the photograph.


